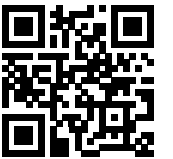

How can I securely pay by card online?

Paying by card when buying goods over the Internet is becoming more and more popular. But this is also attracting the attention of fraudsters. Make sure to follow these most important do's and don'ts when shopping online.



What else can I do?

Ask your bank or card issuer about your card's security features (e.g. deactivating contactless payments or online shopping). Where possible, only activate the features that you use every day, as this offers additional protection against card fraud.

What you should know:



Only buy from trusted online retailers. The "Trusted Shops" certificate helps consumers identify these.



When receiving payment requests, always check the sender and the amount.



Bank and card issuers will never ask you for your card details via email, so never give out this information.



Always check your card statements and report suspicious transactions straight away.



Never pass on confirmation codes to third parties.



Make sure you are on secure websites. You can recognise this by the abbreviation "https" in the web address.



Protect your computer with anti-virus programs and keep your web browser and operating system up-to-date.



Report any claims to the police.

Always remember to:

- Set your card limit only as high as is necessary.
- Always keep your card in a safe place.
- Memorize your PIN code.
- Always keep your identification details such as passwords, PIN or signature separately from your card.
